In the Applications panel at the far right look for "LabVantage".

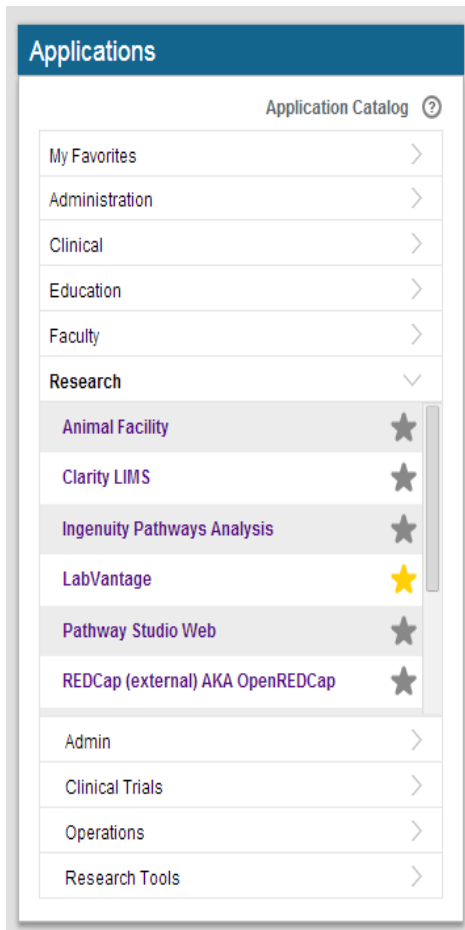
